Responsibilities Include

- Cares for the physical well-being of everyone in camp.
- Takes care of all cases of illness and accidents of campers and staff.
- Keeps health records; records all treatment inbound book and other health information including insurance claims.
- Maintains first aid equipment.
- Inventories all medical supplies at the end of the camp season. Putting together all Med Kit Backpacks for each camp group
- Prepares records for office files, including health forms for all campers and staff, inventories, daily treatment sheets, individual health records, and accident and illness insurance forms.
- Notifies Camp Director immediately of all serious illnesses and Accidents.
- Transports any ill or injured person to the doctor or the hospital when needed.
- Dispenses and keeps a record of daily medications administered.
- Makes sure that medications brought to camp are locked in the medication cupboard in the clinic unless discussed and approved by the Camp Director.

Minimum Requirements

Must be 21 years of age
Registered Nurse (RN) or EMT with a license as required by that state law. Able to disperse medication.
LVN if also certified to dispense medication.
Current First Aid, CPR and AED Certified
Experience in first aid and emergency management
Must possess a valid driver’s license
Must pass background check and drug screening
